GreenDart Awarded Homeland Security Test and Evaluation Contract

On June 27, 2014 the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Customs and Border Protection (CBP) organization awarded GreenDart their Cargo Systems Program Directorate (CSPD) Operational Test and Evaluation (OT&E) Support contract.

Scope of Effort

Under this contract GreenDart, and its teammate TASC, will perform OT&E services associated with CSPD's application systems development and deployment efforts. The GreenDart team will perform OT&E planning, execution, and reporting for the most critical CBP development program – the Automated Commercial Environment (ACE) system. The GreenDart team's effort involves the complicated operational test of various ACE increment releases into the CSPD operational domain, and spans many functional areas of the CSPD mission.

This effort allows GreenDart to bring our team's outstanding OT&E skills into Agile systems development efforts, and deliver accurate and timely assessments on incremental portions of the overall system."
